2026 BUDGET WORKSHOP "EXHIBIT J"

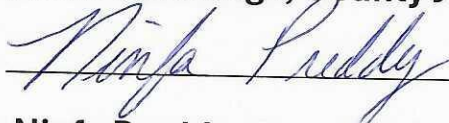
The Court examined and discussed each line item on the budget.
